**Instructions and Information**

1. Complete Registration Form
2. Return Completed Registration to the School Office
3. Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - Appointments will be set up for bank notes to be signed after a completed Registration Form and payment is turned in. You will receive a call from the school office to set up an appointment date and time.

**Requirements for New Students to register for Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. The following information is required for registration:**

- Official State Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate
- Immunization Record (Provide a copy of LINKS Online record)
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Child's last report card if attended another school
- Schedule an interview with the Principal
- A child entering Maltrait Memorial Catholic School must meet age requirements stipulated in the state department Bulletin 741.

**Kindergarten- 5 years old by September 30, 2020**

**Other School Information**

**School Lunch** – Maltrait's School Lunch is provided by the Food and Nutrition Services through the Diocese of Lafayette. Currently the meal price is \$2.30 per day for Pre-K through 8<sup>th</sup> grades. A monthly statement is provided to each family from the Cafeteria Manager, Julie Ford (893-4591). An option to make your payments online is available. At the beginning of the school year, packets will be sent to each family with cost information and an Application to apply for Free or Reduced Lunch.

**Pre-K Program Snack Fees** – Our daily snack program is provided by the staff of Pre-K. The selection is made by the teacher. Some snacks and drinks are coordinated with class lessons.

Snack Fees are to be paid by each quarter. Full Time Student Snack Fee: \$30.00 each quarter

Part Time Student Snack Fee: \$15.00 each quarter

**Kindergarten Program Snack Fees** – Our daily snack program is provided by the staff of Kindergarten. The selection is made by the teacher. Some snacks and drinks are coordinated with class lessons.

Snack Fees are to be paid by each quarter. Snack Fee: \$30.00 each quarter

**Technology Fee** – A Technology Fee is collected from each student in the amount of \$75.00 for the year. Fees are used for school licenses, software, student online programs, upgrades, repairs and equipment replacement.

**Classroom Fees** – Classroom fees are due at the beginning of the school term. These fees include: Supplies, Religion Materials, and Copy Paper.
