Dear Friends, Family, and Alumni of Maltrait,

It is a privilege to be a part of the Maltrait Memorial Catholic School family and witness the abundant faith and support that embraces our school. The impact our school has had in our community for the last 67 years is very evident. Parents and alumni often share with me their stories of the academic and faith-filled foundation Maltrait provided for them, and in many cases, now provide for their children or grandchildren. It is amazing to watch our school grow and serve third, as well as fourth generations of families.

Because of this growth and past support, we have made many substantial school advancements and improvements while keeping our tuition as affordable as possible. Some of the progress we were able to make over the past few years are:

- 2016 – A new **state of the art playground structure and swings** were built to give our students a clean, fun and safe place to play outside. **Interior and exterior door locks, protective screens, and peep holes** were installed as safety precautions.
- 2017 – The dream of having an **air-conditioned gym** came to life and now provides our students, as well as our visitors a cool, comfortable place to interact.
- 2018 – **Intercom and camera systems** were installed as a continuation to our safety improvements. The calling feature enables communication to and from all buildings on campus.
- 2019 – **Annual Appeal established** for future multi-purpose, covered area.

As we continue to focus on facility and safety upgrades for our Maltrait students and families, we have chosen to work on a plan that would construct a **multi-purpose, covered area on the west side of the gym**. It would provide a safe place for covered drop-off and pickup that would be utilized by the entire school. It would also serve as another protective area for physical education classes and other activities throughout the year. After thorough research, we estimate the cost to be \$40,000, and we are halfway to the finish line. With the continued support of our Maltrait families, friends, and alumni, we feel very strongly that we will be able to reach this goal.

We are fully committed to providing each child with academic excellence built on character, compassion, and Catholic values.
