TIPS AND WHAT TO EXPECT!!

Registration Deadline? Participants who do not pre-register may register in person on the day of the event although a t-shirt is not guaranteed.

Early T-Shirt pickup? Yes, registered participants who met the deadline may pick up run t-shirt at Maltrait Memorial Catholic School.

Friday, March 13th 8:00am- 3:00pm

Not a runner? No problem. This Color Fun Run event is all about a color crazy day with family and friends! You may run or walk.

Is the Color Fun Run timed? This is not a timed event. Participants tend to take their sweet time and many don't really care about their speed. We suggest self-timing for anyone desiring a finish time.

Will the color ruin my clothes/shoes? The color does mostly wash out after the event. As with anything dirty, the sooner you wash it the better. (A shirt is provided for each registrant who registers before the deadline.)

Will there be a cleaning station? We will have air blown color cleaning at the end of the run. With a good dusting off, you aren't 100% clean, but you are good for the drive home.

How to protect the inside of my car? Most people bring some towels for the inside of their cars, or a change of clothes.

Do I need to protect my eyes from the color? As with any substance, you want to keep it out of your eyes. Our color throwers make sure to aim low as you pass by. It is a good idea to wear sunglasses. If you forget, we will have some available for purchase for \$1.00.

Are cameras and phones safe to have in the color zones? If you must carry these during the color run, it is recommended to place them in a sealed plastic zip bag.
